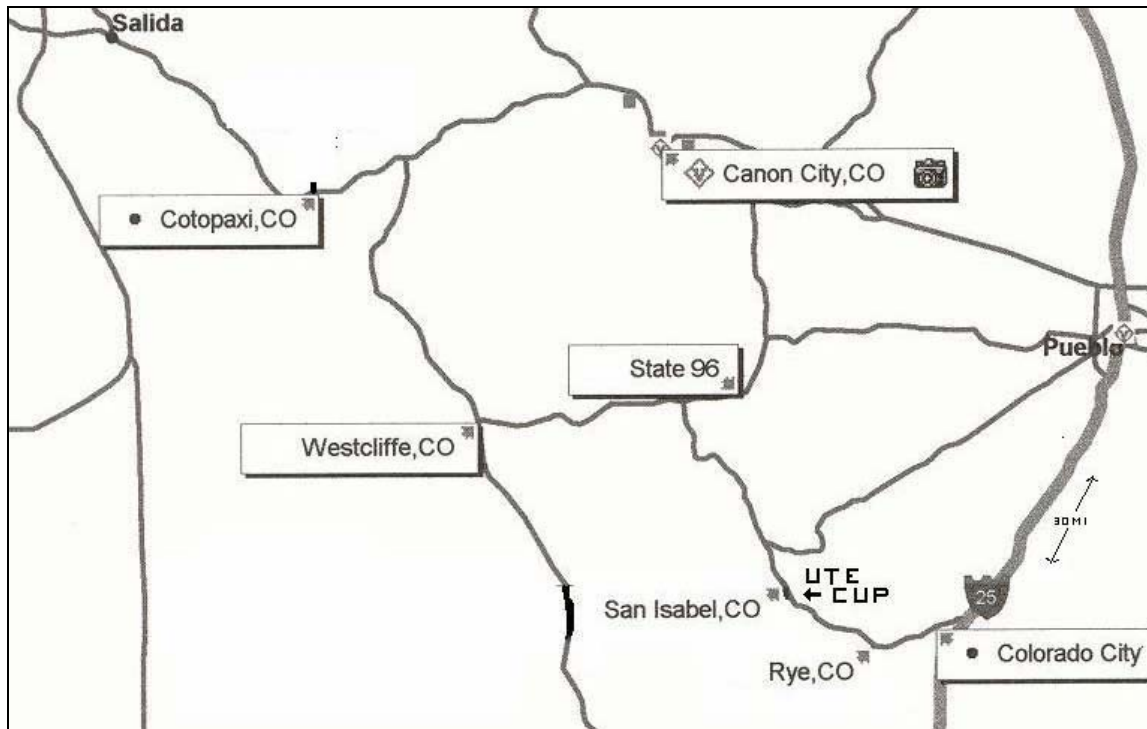

2007 UTE CUP INFORMATION:

This years UTE CUP will be in San Isabel, CO. It will involve parts of the St. Charles Trail, Cisneros Trail, Snowslide Trail and some connecting routes. Lake Isabel is part of the campground for near by fishing. Also, paddleboats are available for rent. The town of San Isabel has a general store and restaurant and is only a short distance from Start/Finish.

Start times will be by random drawing. There will not be a riders meeting, but rider information packets with start times will be available upon your arrival Friday evening. **BE SURE TO PICK UP A RIDER INFORMATION PACKET NO LATER THAN 7:00 A.M. SATURDAY.**

Prepare for all kinds of weather! Snow, Sleet, Cold, Heat, Fog, Rain

ELIGIBILITY - The Ute Cup is open to all riders ranked Intermediate and above, including those competing in the National Series. Although the loop and sections are set for Intermediate/advanced riders, keep in mind that altitude and fatigue play a key role. **THIS TRIAL IS NOT DESIGNED TO BE RIDDEN BY THE BEGINNER TRIALS RIDER.** The RMTA does not permit its Novice class riders or any known Novice-level riders to enter. It should also be noted that machine fatigue is a built- in factor of the event, and the RMTA rule of one motorcycle per rider will be enforced. Past winners include Morgan Kavanaugh, Andy Saum. Sammy Miller, Bill Burgener, Dave Burke Jr. , Curt Comer Jr., Scott Head, Mark Manniko, Ray Peters and Chris Florin

AWARDS - Awards are American Indian in design. The Ute Cup, a traveling award, is a hand made copper pitcher presented to the overall winner. Prized Thunderbird medals are given to the top 40% of the entrants and all finishers receive Thunderbird finisher pins. Special awards are given for best performances each day, slowest finisher, best performance by a rider 40 and over and best performance by a lady. Also, the infamous Bog Trophy, a traveling trophy donated by Xavier Jordi of the Montesa Factory, is awarded to the rider who has the most sensational catastrophe in the traditional bog section.

TEAMS - All riders are encouraged to join a team and compete for much coveted Team rugs which are awarded to the top 3 teams in each class. Being a member of a team adds a decided camaraderie to the event. There are four categories of team competition. A rider may participate on more than one team so long as they are in different classes. All teams consist of three riders.

Team classes are:

SPONSORED: Open to all riders and usually include some of the finest riders in the nation.

VISITING CLUB: Open to all non-RMTA riders from the same club.

RMTA CLUB: RMTA members. Team make-up NOT TO EXCEDE: 1 Champ or Expert, 1 Advanced and 1 Intermediate rider. Teams determined by draw

SENIOR: Any rider 35 or over. Teams determined by draw.

OBSERVERS: As with any event of this scope, many observers will be needed. Each person observing both days will receive a beautiful hand-woven Indian rug, in addition to having the opportunity to spend a memorable weekend in the stunning Colorado High Country. Get involved; don't sit in the camper all weekend. We are counting on everyone to help get volunteers to observe.
